UFES suspends presential activities starting tomorrow, March 17th.

Rector Reinaldo Centoducatte approved on Monday, March 16th, the draft of a text to regulate the reorganization of academic, administrative activities and events promoted by UFES, as a preventive measure against Covid-19, from March 17th to 29th, 2020.

According to the draft text, undergraduate and graduate in-class courses and collective events (graduations, lectures, seminars, plays, cinema sessions, etc.) are suspended. Deans will issue regulations guiding the re-planning of classes and other activities inherent to teaching, research and extension.

Face-to-face meetings will also be suspended, including those for academic and administrative purposes, and replaced by virtual meetings; travel authorization and travel allowances to staff (teaching and administrative) and students, for international trips and to states with high incidence of cases are also suspended.

From March 23th-29th activities at the university's childcare facility will also be suspended, and this suspension can be extended.

The decision was approved ad referendum by the plenary of the University Council, considering the National Contingency Plan for Human Infection for the new coronavirus Covid-19 of the Health Surveillance Secretariat of the Ministry of Health.
